Controlling a waggler at range on a large stillwater where there is a heavy chop demands expert technique and control. Working a stick float along a reed margin when the river is really pushing through, calls for complete concentration if the bait is going to behave anything like naturally. Long trotting with an Avon float at vast distances in crystal clear water, is one of the high arts, totally unforgiving of any single mistake. The lift method. Laying on. Stret-pegging. Slider floats. Shot dragging. The river waggler. Endless skills and challenges to keep you occupied for life.

At Hardy, we realise that really good float techniques demand the very highest of your gear. The margin of error is tiny. This is a fishing technique right on the edge. The Specialist 14' float rod offers better control when fishing flowing or deeper water, while retaining a lovely forgiving action.

- Casting weights – 1g-15g

MARKSMAN SPECIALIST 15' FLOAT ROD

Demanding venues often require longer rods to get the best from them. The Specialist 15' has no equal, being powerful and yet surprisingly forgiving with its extended reach.

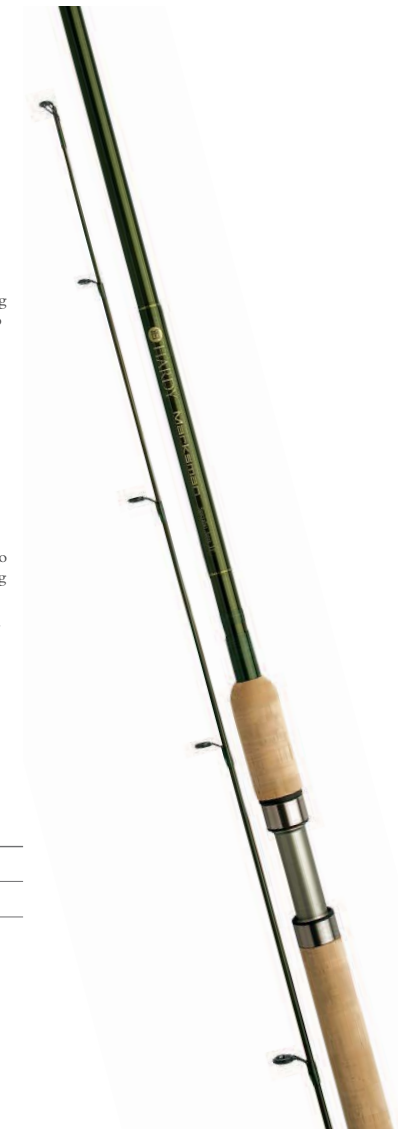

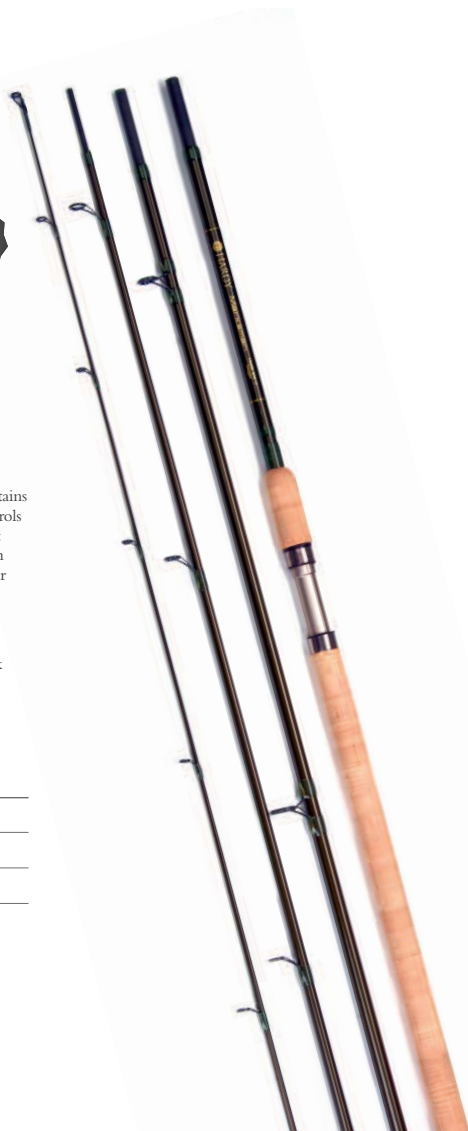

The Hardy Anti-Lock action, incorporated into the blank, produces almost 'electric' fish-playing experience.

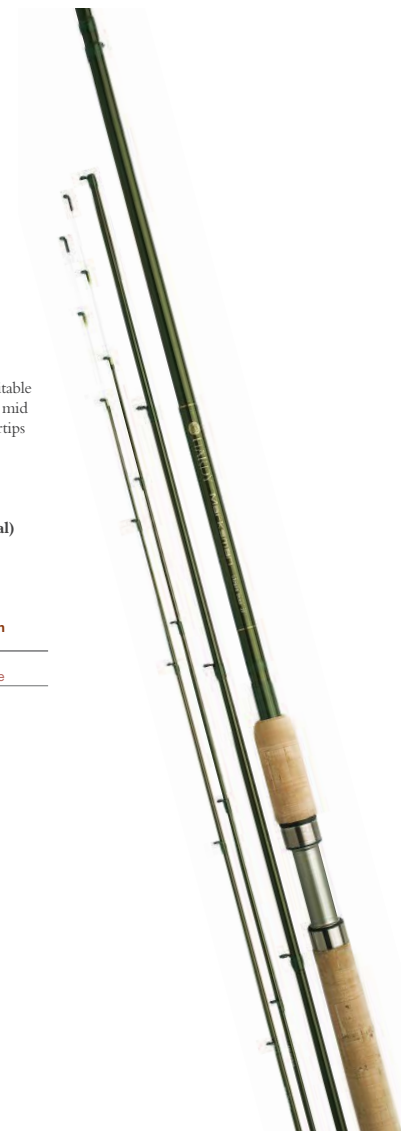

LAYERING SYSTEM

BASE LAYER – WORN NEXT TO THE SKIN

Worn next to the skin, the base layer keeps you comfortable by wicking moisture away. Using fast-drying and hardwearing synthetic fabrics, the base layer is fundamental to the layering system. When you start to use energy the body starts to sweat. If this moisture is left next to the skin this can create discomfort and will feel cold especially during rest. Wicking fabrics move this moisture to the next layer and prevent it being kept next to the skin. A base layer garment is insulating, body fitting, soft and creates a comfort layer, and is warm to touch. It also helps you to keep cool when hot.

MID LAYER – INSULATION

The mid layer provides insulation to ensure you stay warm in colder conditions. It also moves moisture on to the next layer. Made from fabrics that trap and hold warm air. The primary choice for mid layer fabric is polyester fleece as this is lightweight, durable, has very low water absorbency, dries quickly and wicks moisture. A choice of fleece weights are available from a lightweight fleece top to a windproof laminated fleece. Windproof fleece fabric adds additional properties of preventing wind-chill and adding protection from light rain.

BREATHABLE OUTER LAYER – PROTECTION AGAINST THE ELEMENTS

Providing protection from wind and rain, the outer layer keeps the elements out whilst also helping to release moisture from the previous layer. The outer layer needs to stop the rain, keep you dry, and keep out the wind, retaining heat in the previous layers. With a breathable outer layer the moisture wicked from the skin through the base and mid layer needs to escape to the atmosphere. A breathable outer layer lets this happen.

Some garments might serve a dual purpose on mid or outer layer garments during weather when protection from rain isn't required.

HARDY WADING

BREATHABLE CHESTWADERS HAVE REVOLUTIONIZED THE WAY WE FISH AND THEY HAVE MADE THE DAYS OF RUBBER A DISTANT NIGHTMARE.

Rubber 'chesties' were so debilitatingly hot in summer to walk more than a few yards was torture. They were freezing cold in winter. They were prone to leaks, they were unhygienic and now they can be a distant memory. Breathables are as light and as comfortable to wear as a pair of normal pants. You barely notice that you're wearing them and it's this freedom and comfort that can bring so much flexibility to the ways you approach your fishing.

It's traditional to link chestwaders with fly fishing when you often need to get out into the current to present your fly to its ultimate advantage. But, in reality, chestwaders are vital kit for any fisherman fly, lure, bait or sea.

If you're long trotting, getting out into the flow makes the mending of the line so much easier. If you're touch legering, getting directly upstream of the bait gives you a far better angle, far more positive bite indication. If you're lure fishing for pike, then wading the gravels allows you to cast into the reed-fringed bay or the far side of the lily pads. If you're bass fishing in the surf, how can you possibly restrict yourself to the beach?

Even if you find yourself on the bank, chestwaders are invaluable in foul weather. Put on a good waterproof jacket, hood and chestwaders and you are untouchable, impervious to the storms.

If it's cold, simply put on good base layers and you will be snug, warm and dry and concentrating wholly on your sport.

But there are wading rules. Don't wade in cloudy water. Don't go out beyond your safety zone. Lifejackets and wading sticks are invaluable safety items. Wade in company, with a whistle if you're going to be separated. Wading revolutionizes your fishing... providing you show commonsense.

Chestwaders are a significant investment in your fishing. Hang them out to dry and air after every fishing expedition. Following the instructions, wash them regularly to get rid of potentially damaging grit and dirt. Mend any leaks, however small, as soon as possible. Avoid really sharp thorns and brambles and take care around barbed-wire.

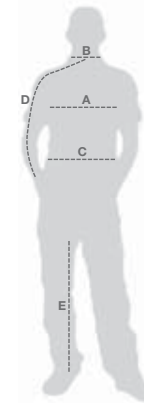

- D. Sleeve length: Measure from the centre back of your neck with your arm slightly bent, following the tape around to your wrist bone.
- E. Inside leg: Measure from crotch to ankle bone.

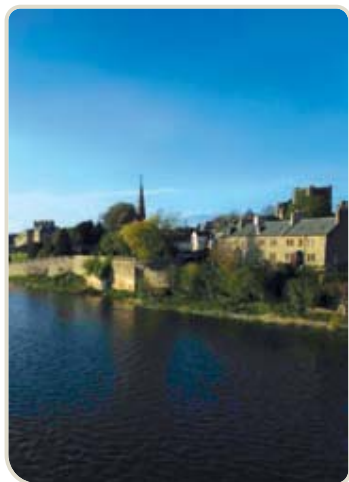
